

The IHA Western Pleasure Committee would like to thank all of the western riders who came to us with questions and concerns. We really value your input, since you see the show process from a totally different perspective than we do. We have been able to make the following changes, which you can pencil into your prize book for the 2010 show series.

The “order-of-go” is not the order seen in the prize book. Class 11, Hunter in Hand, will be held right after Class 5H, Colorbreed Showmanship. The pattern for this was accidentally omitted from the booklet. It is the same pattern that was used last year and will be available the day of the show, along with the other posted patterns.

There were some typo’s regarding when some trail classes would start. The Leadline Trail participants should go to the trail ring right after their Leadline Class, which is Class 7, not Class 6 as written. Hunter Trail should go to the trail ring right after the Hunter Under Saddle class, which is Class 12, not Class 9 as written.

The Hobby Horse Rookie Rewards program for Horsemanship will be run exactly as it was run last year and will be open to Buckaroo through Amateur. There will be a Youth and Adult award, as there was last year. The Novice and Amateur Divisions will stay combined but points for the Horsemanship class will be tallied by Youth or Adult status for the benefit of the award.

The Bridleless Class will be truly bridleless, with no halter, bitless bridle or other “headgear” being used. There will be a simple horsemanship type pattern that will be posted the day of the show along with the other patterns.
